

The Regions of Fiji Nadi – Ultimate Meetings



Nadi, the third largest city, is a 10 minute car ride from Nadi International Airport and serves as the 'gateway' to the rest of Fiji.

Driven by tourism, Nadi offers restaurants of every international flavour, curio shops for the passionate shopper and a focal point for the numerous stop-over hotels, nearby Denarau Island resorts, golf, tennis and cruise liners.

Area activities include shotover jet boat rides, highland trekking and viewing the beautiful orchids at the Garden of the Sleeping Giant.

Mamanucas - Perfect incentives



The Mamanuca Islands, immediately west of Nadi Bay and Viti Levu, are set amongst deep blue waters with coral reefs of turquoise and pastel green.

These islands, easily accessible by boat, plane and helicopter are the home to more than a dozen resorts, each on its own separate island.

The Mamanucas offer some of Fiji's most awesome beauty! Among the myriad of sports and cultural activity opportunities, these island waters boast excellent diving, snorkeling and wonderful sailing.

Coral Coast - Ultimate meetings



The Coral Coast area runs 100km (60 miles) across the southern coast of Viti Levu from Momi, 12 miles south of Nadi to Pacific Harbour.

The coastline offers a range of spectacular tropical scenery from "Caribbean" pine mountains cascading down to the shores, sugar cane fields, coral lagoons and seemingly endless beaches.

It is the home to some of Fiji's most famous international-style resorts as well as extensive sightseeing opportunities such as Sigatoka's sand dunes and expeditions into the hinterland.

The Coral Coast offers every activity imaginable, from river rafting or cruising to cave touring and authentic Fijian village tours.

Northern Islands - Perfect Incentives



The Northern Islands include Fiji's second and third largest islands, Vanua Levu and Taveuni, known as the "Garden Island" for its rich floral and rainforest habitat.

It also boasts of several smaller islands featuring some of Fiji's best diving and intimate resort getaways.

Accessible by plane or local ferries, northern resorts offer a real opportunity to interact more closely with the people and culture of Fiji and deliver a vacation experience that just doesn't exist anywhere else in the world.
