Featured on TV shows including "Ghost Hunters International" and the supernatural horror movie "The Quarantine Hauntings", Sydney's Quarantine Station on North Head is one of Australia's most haunted sites. An operational quarantine station from 1833 - 1984, stories of ghosts and paranormal occurrences began to be reported during this time. Ghost tours have operated here since the early 1990s.
